



## Altered 45 Record Frame

### Supplies:

45 record (larger than a CD, for those born after 1980)  
Heat gun (Milwaukee)  
3 kinds of Patterned cardstock (Die Cuts with a View-Rock Star Stack)  
Circle cutter (Creative Memories)  
Scotch double stick tape (3M)

### Instructions:

1. Heat the record across the median with the heat gun until it softens enough to fold in half. (Do this in a well ventilated area!) The vinyl will become pliable and will bend just like a taco shell.
2. Cut the paper circle large enough to cover the paper on the middle of the record (about 3 3/4" diameters).
3. Attach paper circle over the record. Photo 2



4. Cut a 4" circle from a second patterned paper and a 4 1/4" circle from the third patterned paper.
5. Layer 4" circle over 4 1/4" circle.
6. Attach layered circles to the record so that the circles extend above the folded record as shown.

7. Cut embellishments and word from patterned cardstock and add to frame.
8. Add photo and sign your art!
